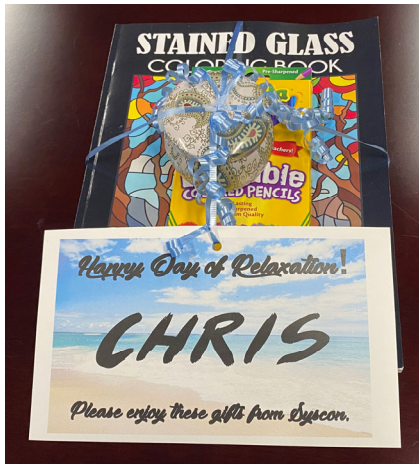

## Microsoft Server 2012 R2 Operating System—RIP!

In October 2023, this server operating system will reach its final conclusion. No longer supported, all extended support will end. If you're running this server operating system (OS), it needs to be upgraded, equipment replaced with a new operating system, or you need to consider a move to the cloud.

BTW—if you're a Sage 100 Contractor user, you have another very good reason to make a change. *S100C version 25 will not install on this end-of-life OS.* If you still run a local network, let's jump on a call! - CMW

## Quarantined Email from a Known Sender

We've seen this several times. An incoming email is Quarantined by your anti-spam software. You see it's from a vendor you know and recognize, so you release it from quarantine. BUT, before you do, here's something to consider.

Perhaps this is a known and trusted vendor. But there's a reason the scanning software flagged it. There's a very real possibility that the vendor has been compromised or this specific person's email has been compromised and they don't even know it yet!

You'd actually be doing your trusted vendor a favor if you dug into this a bit.

It's worth asking a tech if the email is truly risky, and if so, letting the vendor know that they should engage their tech team to take a look.

We're in this together—let's have each other's back! —CMW

## You Might Look Like Spam!

We've seen a growing number of clients going back to sending large group email messages to their internal teams or other groups. If your target list has 20 or more names, do NOT send the email through regular channels.

There are some excellent spam filters out there. When an email has more than 20 recipients, it automatically receives a higher possible spam score and it's very possible the email will not be delivered.

Consider a service like Mail Chimp or Constant Contact. There are some 'free' levels and some paid options. If you use a CRM, setup the DKIM configurations and use their services to get the email delivered safely.

What's the big deal? If your domain name (the company web address, ours is Syscon-inc.com) is seen as sending spam, your email may not get to the recipients, but even worse, it might be blacklisted, causing other 'regular' email to be intercepted, as well. If you need options, check in with the techs and we can offer some suggestions. —CMW

## Background Images, Avatars

Coming soon: Frosted Glass is a type of background effect that helps users keep their privacy with a background blur, but in a more professional and creative way. It lets users have graphics together with a blur effect. With the new frosted glass effect, the transparent area is turned into a blur while the graphic remains.

Another fun feature is the Avatar which is available in preview. You make a digital Avatar of yourself that displays instead of your camera view. As you speak, the mouth will move, but it doesn't follow hand/head gestures (yet!). Press a button to trigger a nod or make a thoughtful gesture. —CMW

## S100C – RTF Printer

So what is this and when/why would you use it?

Sage comes with two default printers, one is the S100C PDF printer which generates PDF's, and the other is the RTF print driver.

The RTF printer will create a Word-style document of whatever you're printing. This allows you to make simple changes such as a Progress Billing Applications number, or other small edit with relative ease. Then print the 'Word' document as a PDF and send as usual.

Client Statements and Progress Bills are the most common uses I've seen. It's a handy tool. – CMW

## WA State Cares Act – Starting July 1st

Beginning July 1st, 2023, WA State employers are to deduct 0.58% (no wage limit) from employees' checks for the new WA State Cares act. Lots to consider, so here's what we learned and what you need to know!

The goal is for all residents to have disability benefits. Some employers already provide this type of coverage option, so if an employee already had coverage, they could request an exemption letter. If an employee can provide their exemption letter, they do not have to participate in this deduction.

Other exemptions are Active Duty Military, home mailing addresses outside of WA, or those over 65.5 years. Why an age guideline? Because although paying into the fund starts in July 2023, there is a 10-year delay to use the benefits!

So for now, any new hires that have the exemption letter are exempt from the deduction. Otherwise all new hires, and all existing employees who don't have the letter are to have the deduction added to their payroll. Payments will be

made quarterly to the WA Employment Security Department, above and beyond the SUI. We haven't seen the reports yet, so Q3 should be interesting! - CMW

## BIM Services – A Growing Need

We were recently approached by an excellent vendor of ours about their new BIM Services offering and if it would be a fit for our clients. We hear about 'BIM' all the time but haven't heard much discussion across our client base, so we decided to meet with the vendor.

Turns out there is a growing contractual obligation to provide BIM documents for government projects and hospitals exceeding \$5,000,000. The goal is electronic drawings of the Subcontractors' work, compliance with original Architectural specs, and As-Built drawings, along with other documentation.

If new contracts require these documents and you don't have the software expertise, we have an excellent resource you can talk with. ## ACH Scam – Remind Your Team

Recently a client received an email asking that future ACH payments go to a new bank and account. It was a really 'good' email and in many ways, looked legit; it wasn't!

All the names, spellings, and other details looked just right. When you got to the bottom of the email, the domain

name was one letter off, just one letter!

Rather than try to be a detective, we recommend you have an internal policy with absolutely no exceptions; all requests to change bank information – employees, vendors, clients – must involve a phone call that you initiate with a primary contact, no exceptions! If you experience fraud, contact the bank, ask that the FBI get involved, escalate to the appropriate law enforcement agencies. Then go sooth your team member; no one wants to have been tricked and I'm sure they feel just awful. Provide some encouragement, then re-train the team! -CMW

## A Few S100C Tips

Changing banks? Many of us have a default General Ledger account in various cash screens including 3-3, 1-2, 1-1, 4-3-2, 5-2-4, and so on. If you'd like to **change the account default**, be sure you log in with Administrator Rights, then in the account field, enter the new account, then go back to the field and hit the F7 key. Click on the pull down arrow in the 'Default entry to' field and choose the new account, then Save. You've just updated the default account.

There's a lot of confusion about the **Reference#** field in the 3-2 and 4-2 screens. It's designed to allow you to reference an existing invoice/credit to which the new record applies.

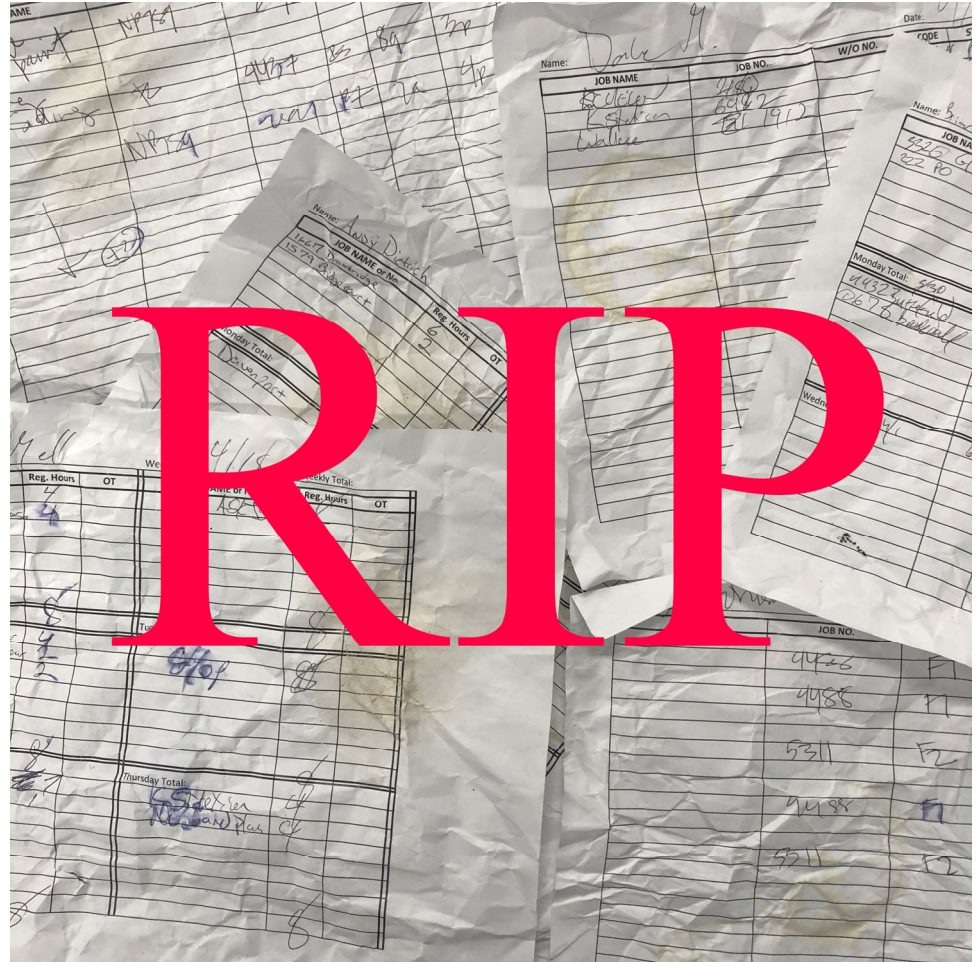
In either screen, enter the credit (sometimes an invoice) as usual. In the Reference# field, enter the invoice/credit to which the new record will be applied. When you save, it will say the referenced invoice was, or was not found. If it was found, you can choose Yes to apply the new record right away, or No if you don't want to apply it, or Cancel if it says 'was not' found!

This saves time by applying and clearing the records, the Payment details are right there, and keeps them off your Aging reports! - CMW
